

## **Five Days Workshop on Extraction, Transformation, Processing and Presentation of Micro-level Data of NSSO and ASI from 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2014**

### **Concept Note**

Department of Economics University of Kashmir in collaboration with Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MOSPI), GOI is conducting a **“Five Days Workshop on Extraction, transformation, processing and presentation of Micro-level data of NSSO and ASI”** from 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2014. The workshop is expected to increase the awareness of participants on use and applications of NSSO and ASI data which are an indispensable data set for Socio-Economic and Industry related research work. This workshop will definitely go a long way in enhancing the research capacity of different stakeholders across disciplines and will enhance the reach and reliability of research conducted in the concerned areas.

Research related to labour force, work participation, poverty, inequality, unemployment, migration are actually based on NSSO data sets, however due to the complexities in extraction of the same most of the time primary surveys are resorted to, which for proper generalisation need to be supplemented with these data sets.

The Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) is the principal source of industrial statistics in India. It provides statistical information to assess and evaluate, objectively and realistically, the changes in the growth, composition and structure of organised manufacturing sector. Industrial sector occupies an important position in the Indian economy and has a pivotal role to play in the rapid and balanced economic development. Viewed in this context the collection and dissemination of ASI data, on a regular basis, are of vital importance.

It is to increase the awareness about the use of NSSO and ASI data that the present workshop is being conducted as a maiden attempt in this direction in the state of Jammu and Kashmir.

It is in this backdrop that applications are invited from Research scholars and faculty members engaged in Socio-Economic and Industry related research work.

Three resource persons from MOSPI will impart training to participants. Apart from the main theme the resource persons will be extensively deliberating upon the use of STATA 13 available with the department. **Each participant will be required to bring along a personal Laptop.**

We will be in a position to accommodate only 20 out of station participants. Due to paucity of funds no TA/DA will be reimbursed. We will be happy to facilitate local accommodation, if requested.
