

HISTORY

The Department of Economics was established in 1966, with an initial intake capacity of 30 students and four faculty members, in a three room accommodation at the old Humanities block of University of Kashmir. It was shifted to old administrative block and then to Naseem Bagh Huts in 1975. Since then, the Department has grown by leaps and bounds, and currently located in the main campus, it comprises of ten faculty members, dedicated to teaching and research, serving annually, approximately 200 students and scholars. In 1978, the department conferred its first PhD degree upon Mr. Mehraj Krishan Dhar, who subsequently started his career as a Lecturer at SKUAST-K. Ms. Mahmoda Shafi became the first woman of the department to earn a PhD in 1982. She later worked in the Higher Education Department and retired in 2010 as the Principal of Government Degree College for Women, M. A. Road, Srinagar.

This department has a rich legacy of organising international and national events like conferences, seminars and workshops. Way back in 1972, we had the honour of hosting the eminent welfare economist and Nobel laureate Prof. Amartya Sen. Carrying forth this legacy, such events are organised regularly to enable an environment of intellectual exchange and foster academic collaborations.


The participation of faculty members in esteemed international and national academic programs has further enriched the department's legacy. During 1985-86, Prof. Nisar Ali was engaged in an exchange program with the Hungarian Institute of Economics. In 1988, Prof. Dost Mohammad, participated in an exchange program in Germany. He was also awarded with the prestigious Fulbright Fellowship in 2005. Moreover, Prof. M. S. Bhatt was a member of the Godbhole Committee on economic reforms of J&K in 1998. Between 2003 and 2006, Prof. Ab. Wahid Qureshi, Prof. Nisar Ali, and Prof. Effat Yasmin participated in the U.S International Visitors Leadership Program. Prof. R. L. Bhat and Prof. A. S. Bhat prepared J&K State Human Development Report 2006. Prof. G. M Bhat taught at King Saud University, Riyadh during 2009-10. Dr. Haseeb Drabu was a member of expert committee during UPA 1 with Rangarajan as its chairman in 2012. In 2025, Dr. Javaid Iqbal Khan participated in the Common Review Mission of the Ministry of Rural Development, GOI. These rich and valuable experiences have promoted intellectual diversity within the department.

Additionally, our faculty and alumni have held prominent administrative positions like Finance Minister of J&K, Vice Chancellors, IAS, IES, members of the Finance Commission, Board of Directors of J&K Bank, Directors in the Planning department, and administrators in higher and secondary school education.





Evaluating the economic impact of climate change, natural resource management, and public willingness to pay for environmental improvements.



RESEARCH AND OTHER FACILITIES

LIBRARY

The department has a rich and up-to-date library. It houses a large collection of books, references, research thesis and rare manuscripts. There is a dedicated corner for books donated by alumni of the department. The departmental library subscribes to reputed journals and offers students, research scholars, and faculty members access to national and local dailies like The Economic Times, The Hindu, The Indian Express, and Greater Kashmir. Important publications of J&K government, viz Economic Surveys and Statistical Digests are also available in the department's library. University publication like annual reports and student magazines are also displayed in the library. As a novel practice, the departmental library has a dedicated "Wall of Nobel Laureates". Photographs of all Nobel laureates in Economic Sciences are displayed on this wall to inspire young minds - students, scholars and faculty alike.



CENSUS WORK STATION CUM SEMINAR HALL

A state-of-the-art Census Work Station has been established within the department under an MOU with the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India and the Office of the Registrar General India (ORGI). It includes a server, and it also offers an audio and video conferencing facility. The workstation offers access to the census data ranging from the census year 1901 to the census year 2011.



RESEARCH LAB

The department has a spacious and well-equipped research lab. It caters to the research needs of the scholars and faculty members. This lab has sixteen computer systems and a projector device. Latest statistical packages and datasets are available at this facility. Additionally, 24x7 WIFI connectivity and power back up solutions have been ensured for uninterrupted research outputs.



SMART CLASS ROOMS

The department has three digital smart class rooms with modern facility for having classes in both online and offline mode. All three class rooms are equipped with WIFI facility as well.



JOURNALS AND DATABASES

The department gets access to a variety of reputed journals through the Allama Iqbal Library (central library) of the University of Kashmir. These journals are The International Trade Journal (Taylor and Francis), Journal of Developmental Economics (Elsevier), South Asian Journal of Macroeconomics and Public Finance (Sage Publications), Environment, Development and Sustainability (Springer), and Economic and Political Weekly (Sameeksha Trust). The department also gets access to databases of the EPWRF India Time Series, the CMIE's States of India and Consumer Pyramid Household Survey, and Indiastat.




