ECO22107DCE	Economics of Health and Education	This course deals with two important components of human resource development viz education and health. It is intended to provide a basic understanding of role of education and health to economic development both at micro and macro levels.
ECO22001OE	Basic Microeconomics	The Course explores what microeconomics in broader framework deals with and aims to develop basic understanding of microeconomics among students from non- economic background
ECO22305DCE	Economics of Conflict, Peace and Development	To date, the study of conflicts has been dominated by political scientists, which prejudices the phenomenon as purely political. However, the use of economic theory and statistical evidence alongside the traditional case-studies can offer valuable analytical insights on the causes of inter- and intrastate conflicts and its effect on economic development. Students are introduced to models of conflict also.
ECO22405DCE	Research Methodology	This course attempts to introduce students to the foundations of social science research in general and economics in particular. It attempts to make students understand various statistical tools required for compilation, tabulation and presentation of primary as well as secondary data. It also discusses the various steps for preparing a research/project report
