Reassess the hypotheses framed for the current research objective to ensure clarity and alignment with the theoretical framework. Also address inconsistencies in the results and strive for concrete, verifiable outcomes.

Rugaya Akther was suggested to:

Explain practical implications of the findings. Also suggest policy measures.

Sameer Ahmad Sofi was suggested to:

Expand the scope of the analysis, if possible, by incorporating data on other forms of substance abuse prevalent among economically disadvantaged populations in developing economies. His efforts to get first paper published in High indexed Sage Journal were appreciated by RPAC.

Muncebul Maqbool was suggested to:

Move beyond the descriptive analysis by incorporating estimation techniques to derive conclusive findings for the objective under reference.

General Recommendations to All Scholars:

- 1. Scholars must refine their understanding and application of research methods.
- 2. Build a robust theoretical framework to underpin empirical findings.
- 3. Formulate hypotheses, research objectives, and questions that are coherently aligned with the theoretical framework and the overall purpose of the study.
- 4. Present the highlights of the paper based on their Ph.D. thesis, published in any of the scoops indexed journal along with findings of second objective in RPAC 3, scheduled for first week of May 2025.
- 5. Finaly Incorporate all suggested revisions and refinements into the research framework prior to the next review meeting.

Concluding remarks
